


Help Your Students Harness the Power of Their Personality

7	Students learn to use the power of their style by considering, "Is my bird at its best?"
8	Students learn how to read the styles of others as they answer, "Which bird are they?"
9	Students learn to flex their styles as they answer, "What would the Chameleon do?"
10	Students review and summarize their learning about the styles and themselves.
